What We Do

We, the Social Justice Ministry of St. Paul Catholic Church:

- Serve as a resource on social issues and services in the parish.
 - Assist the Pro-Life 4 Life Ministry in their mission to protect the life of the unborn.
 - Provide emergency funds for parishioners and others in need.
 - Organize the Jesse Giving Tree for the collecting of Christmas gifts for children in need in our parish.
 - Collect baby items for Maryhouse, the Sacramento Life Center and/or Well-spring.
 - Provide new clothes, as needed, for our parish children, who are receiving their First Communion or Confirmation.
 - Assist the Knights of Columbus with the distribution of holiday food boxes in our parish.
- Raise funds to buy shoes for children in need in our area.
 - Collect and distribute bottled water to the homeless during the summer months.
 - Occasional collection of items such as bath towels, eating utensils, coffee cups, etc., for Maryhouse or Well-spring.
