3. Follow Jesus in His compassionate love for the poor and the suffering of the world.

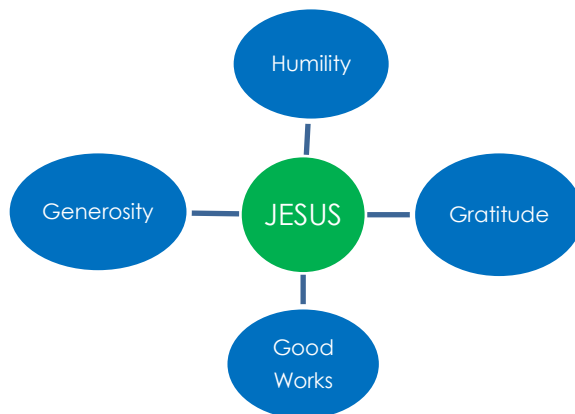
## DESIRES
