Study of the Bible, the scripture, the Word of God, is an essential need in our spiritual growth as Catholics.



Scripture Institute 2007—2008

To meet this need, the Diocese of Sacramento has created the Scripture Institute.

The Institute consists of three 6-week cycles focusing on the Old Testament, the Gospels, and the Acts of the Apostles and Epistles.

Sessions will include direct instruction by professors of scripture, time for breaking open the Word, and group study and prayer.

All classes will be held in the evening, one night per week at the Diocesan Pastoral Center—a central location with ample free parking.

Who Should Attend?

The Institute is open to anyone interested in learning more about scripture from a Catholic perspective:

- Lay women and men
- Parents and grandparents
- Young married and single adults
- Catechists who work with children, RCIA, teens or adult faith formation.
- Anyone involved in parish ministry — youth ministers, teachers and administrators parish council members.
- Those who are new to the faith or exploring the Catholic faith — neophytes — RCIA participants.
- Students who want to broaden their understanding of scripture — college students high school students.

When?

The 2007-2008 Scripture Institute consists of evening classes, one night per week beginning Oct 2, 2007 through March 11, 2008.

Students may register for individual courses, a complete cycle, or the entire program consisting of all three cycles.
